December 7-8 Reach-11 & Usery Mountain

We have a big weekend of navigation fun coming up, with a GPHXO event on Saturday and an Adrenaline Adventure Sports event on Sunday.

Dec. 7 - 2 Hour Score-O & JROTC

For JROTC participants, we have set a single Classic-O Red course, with Check-In beginning at 7 am. The JROTC Classic-O event is not open to the general public, although the controls for this event will be part of the 2-Hour Score-O event.

For the general public, we have set a 2-Hour Score-O course (which includes the JROTC controls). Check-In and Registration begins at 9 am, and competitors can start any time between 10 and noon.

Both courses close at 2 pm. Points will be deducted for late finishers.

The Score-O takes place in an area that is

mostly open desert, with limited elevation variation. Navigation will consist mainly of observing vegetation differences and following a series of trails and re-entrants which crisscross the area. Each participant is given 2 hours to find as many controls as they can.

Score-O even cost: (member / non member)

Individual: \$5 / \$10

Family or team: \$8 / \$15

Score-O participants - **plan to bring:**

- whistle (available for \$1 purchase)
- compass (available for \$1 rent)
- water (we'll have some, but bring your own!)
- sunscreen, sturdy hiking shoes, long pants (some thick vegetation on course)

Participants under age 18:

All participants under age 18 are now required to have a signed parental consent form on file with the club. You can complete the form (available on the gphxo.org website) before the event and either scan it and send it to us by e-mail or bring it with you to the event.

Directions to Reach 11 Complex

The Reach 11 Sports Complex is located in the North Valley, not far from where the State Route 51 meets the Loop 101. Exit the 101 at Cave Creek Road, turn north and continue 1 mile to Deer Valley Road. Turn east on Deer Valley and continue to the second entrance into the complex (approximately 0.6 miles). Turn right (south) to enter the complex, continue straight through the round-about, and take the first left turn at the sign "Youth Baseball". Continue on this road to the parking lot at Dozer Field.
